**\*WEEKDAY** MAT ABACUS offers weekday/weekend program

**Tuition fees** include the provision of Learning Texts and Revision. Please collect your course material promptly. MAT ABACUS will not store material beyond 15<sup>th</sup> Sept and if you fail to collect any material by this date you will lose eligibility to it.

**ENROLLMENT -TUITION COURSES:** For a student to be enrolled for tuition courses, the enrollment form must be completed and accompanied by an identification card/document, along with full fees or a **minimum deposit of RWF 80,000 per course**. Students will not be enrolled unless these minimum fees are paid, and **will not receive any course material until full fees are paid**. Any student who has not paid the **minimum deposit by the third class** of the course for a particular paper will not be allowed to enter class for that paper.

**PAYMENT OF FEES:** Once enrolled, students must pay 70% of the fees at the start and 30% by the first week of the following month of study. Students are obliged to clear any outstanding balance by the stated deadline. Any student with fees still outstanding (all papers inclusive) after this period will be declined entry to any class or access to other MAT ABACUS facilities and will need to make a special arrangement with the administration to continue studying.

**OUTSTANDING BALANCES:** No new enrollment into a course will be accepted if there are any outstanding balances from previously enrolled courses. NB. There are no discounts for students with outstanding fees.

## **SPONSORED STUDENTS**

Sponsored students will not be enrolled without either the minimum deposit or an accepted letter of sponsorship. Students who pay for themselves and are subsequently sponsored will obtain a full refund of their own payment

**EXAMINATION FEES.** Your tuition and revision fees are for classes only. **Your full registration, examination and subscription fees must be submitted to the ICPAR by the deadline(s) set by the KASNEB.** We strongly encourage **early registration and payment to the ICPAR**, since this will allow you time to make corrections should there be any errors

**Every student is responsible for their own examination registration and payment. MAT ABACUS has no authority over examination registrations and deadlines, and cannot accept any responsibility if a student fails to register with or pay to the ICPAR in time. Retrospective applications (i.e., after these times) will strictly be rejected. NB. A course may only be deferred once, and then only to the next semester **for the same**.  
There are **no discounts, refunds, transfers or deferrals** for late enrollments or for non-attendance of classes.
